Job Responsibilities:

- Assist in the coordination of the Quality Council Meetings. Gather metrics, prepare slides presentation and schedule meetings. Assist in the preparation of minutes and ensure follow-up actions are completed.
- Assist in the coordination of Escalated Quality Events meetings, including the preparation of minutes and follow-up on pending actions.
- Assist on activities related to any market actions, such as, Field Alert Reports, potential Recalls, or any other regulatory actions.
- Participate on internal audits to proactively identify compliance issues, and provide timely report findings.
- Assist in maintaining and managing processes for qualifications of VistaPharm suppliers.
- Participate on supplier audits to ensure suppliers meet all the Supplier Qualification Program requirements.
- Collect, review, and analyze data to write all the Annual Product Review reports within the established due date.
- Engage in External Audit Processes (Customers, Regulatory, Government Agencies, etc.)
- Follow up on internal and external corrective actions to ensure timely implementation and validate their effectiveness.
